STATEMENT CONCERNING RADIOACTIVITY LEVEL

Issued as Addendum to Sanitary Certificate no.:

One of the tasks of the Norwegian Food Safety Authority is to guarantee the wholesomeness and good quality of seafood from Norway.

The level of radioactive caesium in seafood is monitored by the Norwegian Radiation and Nuclear Safety Authority in collaboration with the Norwegian Institute of Marine Research.

Both wild and farmed Norwegian seafood are monitored for artificial radionuclides annually, mainly for radioactive caesium. The results confirm that concentrations of radioactive caesium in Norwegian seafood is consistently low. Levels of radioactive caesium are below 10 Bq/kg.

Based on the documented very low concentrations, the Norwegian Food Safety Authority can establish that the potential health risk caused by radionuclides in Norwegian seafood is of no concern to the consumer.
