## STATEMENT CONCERNING WHITE FISH MEAL

## Issued as Addendum to Sanitary Certificate No.:

One of the tasks of the Norwegian Food Safety Authority is to guarantee the wholesomeness and good quality of fish and fishery products exported from Norway.

To this end, chemical, physical, microbiological and sensory analyses are performed.

White fish meal is sold as a powder and is used mostly in animal feedings for farmed fish, poultry and pigs. This type of meal is manufactured from either whole fish or filleting offal. The raw material used in the production of white fish meal is from Norway only and consists of white fish species only such as cod, saithe or haddock.

The whole production takes place on board of factory vessels under controlled hygiene conditions and according to the Norwegian Regulations relating to fish meal, fish oil and animal feed and feedstuff.

The Norwegian white fish meal is free of material with risk of containing BSE and microorganisms like Salmonella. It is not containing or not being contaminated by the animal feeding stuff products from other countries.
