### IV. Attestation

I, the undersigned official inspector, certify that:

1. The salmonid fish from which the product in the consignment was derived has been sourced from Norway only
2. The salmonid fish from which the product was derived do not come from a farm infected by, or officially suspected of being infected by, infectious salmon anemia (ISA), or from waters within 10 km or on tidal interchange (whichever is greater) of an infected, or officially suspected farm
3. The salmonid fish from which the product was derived were:
  - a. harvested from populations for which documented health surveillance programmes exist which are administered by the Norwegian Food Safety Authority,
  - b. not slaughtered as an official disease control measure,
  - c. headed, gilled, gutted, and the external and internal surfaces thoroughly washed to remove any extraneous material,
  - d. inspected and graded, ensuring the products for export are free from visible lesions associated with infectious disease and fit for human consumption
  - e. found to be not sexually mature adults/spawners (fish with developed gonads/roe)
  - f. found not to be juvenile salmonid fish (weighing less than 200g in head-off, de-gilled and eviscerated state)
4. The salmonid products in this consignment were processed exclusively in Norway
5. The salmonid fish were processed in premises subject to regular inspection and audit under the supervision of the Norwegian Food Safety Authority to ensure that processing practices and quality control systems are in place
6. The final salmonid products for export to Australia were subject to effective separation controls to ensure the prevention of inadvertent or deliberate substitution, and the prevention of comingling with, or contamination by aquatic animal material originating from countries other than those approved by the competent authorities of Australia
7. Movement of final salmonid products intended for export to Australia have been effectively tracked through all stages of processing
